




Program Activities





Before & After













- Improvement of roadway approaches to the railroad crossing
- Profile changes / widening
- » New medians and sidewalks
- » Culverts and drainage ditch improvements
- Curb and/or shoulder work to tie into existing roadway
- » New pavement markings and signage
- New roadway work adjacent to tracks





- > Relocate utilities
- Install new or improve existing culverts
- Grading and ditch work















- » 4 quadrant gates
- » New signage and pavement markings
- » ADA accessibility directive signage
- Pedestrian crossings / sidewalks
- Extensive liaison with IDOT Highways, local agencies, ICC, FRA, and others
- Detours coordinated with community







- » No boarding in streets
- Platforms not to be used as path to grade crossing
- » Back of platform fencing & diversions channel passenger flow






Fencing

Fencing will be installed along the railroad corridor

- Both sides of the railroad corridor
- Brush and tree clearing
- Coordinated with the local communities
- » Fencing typically will be placed within one-foot of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way:
 - o In urban areas
 - o In select rural areas







PTC is a safety system that notifies the conductor of vehicles on a crossing.

- PTC will be installed on the HSR corridor
 System testing will be conducted this fall.
- Locals will be notified in advance of testing.











An additional order placed for 12 locomotives for a total of 33

The Midwest States group has reached an agreement on equipment ownership and governance

To be tested up to 110 mph in Colorado and up to 125 mph in the Northeast Corridor










Station Improvements

- New ADA compliant boarding platforms






Station Improvements

 Received a discretionary grant to construct a multimodal facility and to make safety improvements

 Construction is anticipated late summer/early fall 2017

Bidding Process

Thank you for your interest in business opportunities with the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) and the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR). The bidding process for both organizations will require prequalification. Please follow the guidelines outlined for IDOT and UPRR. Please note the UPRR will require contractors to be prequalified for each High-Speed Rail (HSR) enoportunity.

Additionally, minority-owned and women-owned companies are required to receive certification through IDOT for the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Certification (DBE) program. IDOT fosters equal opportunity for minority-owned, women-owned and other DBEs in IDOT's federal and statefunded contracts.

Current Business Opportunities Process:

- Prime contractors have 30 days to become prequalified for each business opportunity (see Pregualification Notices).
- After the 30 day period, a list of prequalified prime contractors information will become available on the HSR Current Business Opportunities page of this website.
- Once the prime contractors' information is available, the sub-consultants/DBE's have the opportunity to market their services and to contact the prequalified prime contractors for inclusion in a particular bidding opportunity.


