Service Changes on Nov. 17, 18 and 19



As construction continues to bring 110 mph speeds to the *Lincoln Service*, track work will affect the *Lincoln Service* and *Texas Eagle* between Chicago and St. Louis, with chartered buses replacing trains in some instances.

Train 307: Thursday-Friday, Nov. 17 and 18

Train 307 will operate only between Chicago and Bloomington-Normal on Nov. 17 and 18. Bus service will be provided to and from Lincoln, Springfield, Carlinville, Alton and St. Louis.

Trains 300, 301, 302, 303, 304, 305 and 306 will operate only between Chicago and Bloomington. Bus service will replace all trains (except Train 300) at stations between Bloomington-Normal

Trains 300 – 306: Friday-Saturday, Nov. 18 and 19

Bus service will replace all trains (except Train 300) at stations between Bloomington-Normal and St. Louis. *Please note that buses replacing Trains 302, 304 and 306 will depart earlier than the respective trains, as shown.*

Trains 21/321/421 and 22/322/422: Friday-Saturday, Nov. 18 and 19

- **Southbound Train 21/421** will detour between Chicago and St. Louis on Nov. 18 and 19, and will not stop at Joliet, Pontiac, Bloomington-Normal, Lincoln, Springfield, Carlinville and Alton.
- Northbound Train 22/422 will operate as scheduled to St. Louis. On Nov. 18 and 19, the train will detour between St. Louis and Chicago, and will not stop at Alton, Carlinville, Springfield, Lincoln, and Bloomington-Normal. Customers on Train 22/422 destined for Chicago will remain on the train. Customers on Train 22/422 ticketed to stations between St. Louis and Joliet will be provided chartered buses as replacement transportation.
- Customers traveling to or from Joliet, Pontiac, Bloomington-Normal, Lincoln, Springfield,
 Carlinville and Alton can make reservations aboard the Lincoln Service train/alternate bus service.
- **Possible Delays:** The *Texas Eagle* may encounter delays of up to 45 minutes traveling on the detour.
- Note that Trains 321 and 322 are cancelled on Nov. 18 and 19.
